Highest Purity Zirconium Oxide (ZrO₂) Coating

Type ZK is a relatively-soft, low-viscosity, washcoat-type of Zirconium Oxide (ZrO₂) coating that provides very high purity (>99.9% pure) ZrO₂ which is usable in vacuum and inert atmospheres to 2000 C (3632 F). This coating should NOT be used in air atmospheres (use Z-Aerosol there). Type ZK gives minimal outgassing, complete by 350 C (662C).

Key Attributes

- 1. Provides the good properties of ZrO₃
 - very low thermal conductivity
 - resistant to reactions with many molten or solid materials
 - low electrical conductivity
- 2. Applies like house paints
- 3. Completely outgassed at low temperature -- ideal for mold coating

Ideal Use

- Graphite crucibles and molds used with reactive molten metals
- Anti-stick with brazing and diffusion bonding
- Barrier coating for sintering/ heat-treating reactive metals/materials

Use Notes

- Resuspend if needed. Can dilute with Ethanol or with YK Binder.
- 2. Clean surfaces to be painted of any oils dirt, scale, etc.
- 3. Apply 1-3 layers by brush or spray like ordinary house paint, drying after each layer.
- 4. Allow to dry thoroughly at room temperature before use.
